

Future Farming Project



1. Each pair of cadets will be assigned a new farming technology to investigate. You will prepare a Google slides presentation of your technique with specific pages being created according to the directions. Use size 36 font or greater and present the facts as phrases (bullets OK), not complete sentences.

The presentation will contain the following:

1. **Title slide**

Your system name
At least one picture
Your names

2. **History**

Who invented it? Where? Provide facts as to its development.
This may take several slides—put a picture on each one

3. **Description.**

How does the system work? Describe the principle behind it.
List the cost to both build and maintain.
This will take several slides—put a picture on each one
If you insert a video, it must be less than 4 min.

4. **Crops**

What crops can be grown and harvested?
This may take several slides—put a picture on each one

5. **Advantages and Disadvantages**

Provide at least one advantage and one disadvantage. Put on separate slides with pictures on each. Give no more than three.

4. **Citation slide**—Use two sources, one from each cadet. Put your name on your slide, and add a picture. You will need:

The author's name, if given

The title of the article or page

The title of the website

The URL

The date you accessed it



Examples of website citation:

White, Lori. "The Newest Fad in People Helping People: Little Free Pantries."

How to cite a website with no author

Sometimes, websites do not clearly state who wrote the information on the page. When no author is listed, omit the author information from the citation. Start the citation with the title.

REMINDERS

Use 36 font or greater, no hard to read fonts

Use third person formal language-no "you" or "your"

Do not overload page with text

Use bullets or phrases, not full sentences

No slang or contractions-formal verbiage and punctuation

Image on each page, but a background image can make text hard to read

No extra pages, no attempts at comedy

One citation from each cadet IN PROPER FORMAT
